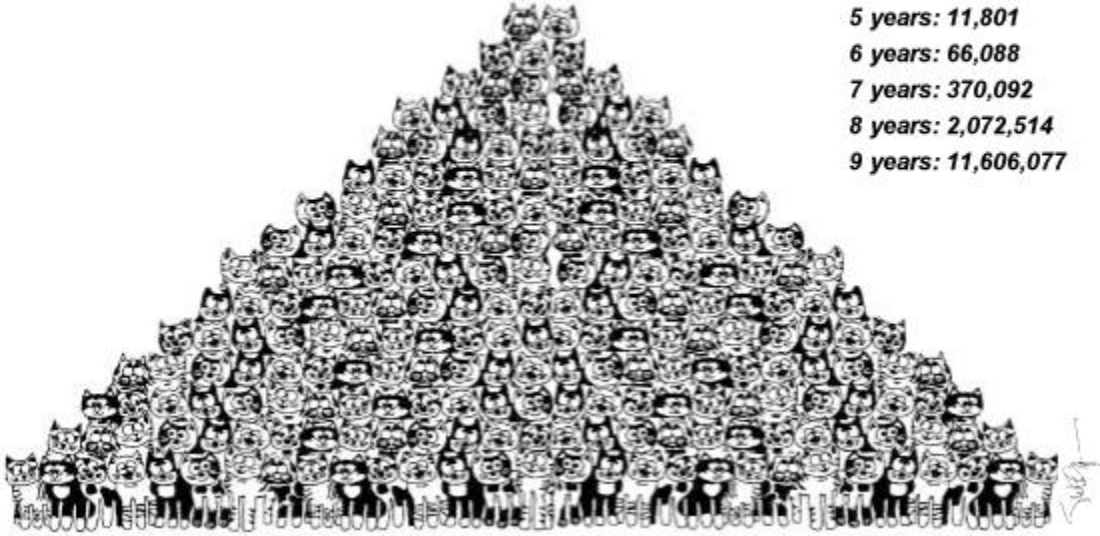




*An unspayed female cat, her mate and all of their offspring, producing 2 litters per year, with 2.8 surviving kittens per litter can total:*

2 years: 67  
3 years: 376  
4 years: 2,107  
5 years: 11,801  
6 years: 66,088  
7 years: 370,092  
8 years: 2,072,514  
9 years: 11,606,077
